

Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself and share with you the overview of our Personal Development Curriculum this academic year here at Bramhall High School.

I am Andrea Woods - PD Curriculum Lead and MFL teacher. It is my role to bring together and sequence Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PHSE) alongside Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) and elements of careers education in order to ensure all students understand themselves, others, and key aspects of the law.

The curriculum is delivered during 2 weekly Form Time periods, assemblies and 4 Focus Sessions throughout the year. The Form Time curriculum is split into six topics and each half term students' study one of these topics in detail.

The sub topics are:

RSE
Health and Wellbeing
Staying Safe On & Offline
Diversity & Equality
British Values & Citizenship
Careers

Alongside our taught curriculum, we enhance our provision by inviting on occasion external organisations and guest speakers into school. These sessions cover important topics such as health and wellbeing, safety on and offline and the dangers of vaping/smoking and drinking. These sessions are age-appropriate, and complement are Form Time material. The aim is for our students to develop into informed, responsible, respectful and happy members of our school community and successful citizens of the future.

We have just had our first focus session in school on Friday 10th October. All students from Years 7 -10 looked at positive role models and their strengths. We discussed the importance of role-models and in particular their qualities. In addition, we explored how students could embody these important attributes and become role models themselves in both the school community and beyond.
