Aim:

To support the academic progress of students studying German, Spanish and French in Years 7, 8 and 9.

The principal aim of homework at KS3 in MFL is to develop a sound knowledge of vocabulary.

The vocabulary within each year is tested three times throughout the year.

Types of regular homework at KS3:

Year 7

20 words to be learnt per fortnight.

Year 8

20 words to be learnt per week. (10 words from Year 7 and 10 new words per week).

Year 9

30 words to be learnt per week. (10 words from Year 7, 10 words from Year 8 and 10 new words per week).

Marking and feedback:

- All vocabulary tests are done in class and are marked straight away. Scores are recorded and averages are monitored.
- Identified students may have lower targets (e.g. 12/20), and once these are met, they are raised.

Monitoring:

- If students fall below the expected standard, the school's behaviour policy for homework will be followed.
- Students who go above and beyond the expected standard will be recognised and rewarded.

Recommended wider reading in addition to the above:
