### **Seasonal Adaptations to uniform**

Due to the continuing warm weather that we are experiencing I can confirm that the decision has been made to make temporary adaptations to the uniform to ensure the comfort of all students during the first three days of term.

- Blazers are not required to be worn.
- Students who choose to wear a skirt can wear socks instead of opaque black tights.

# These adaptations are in place only from Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September.

From Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September all students will be expected to attend school in full uniform.

Please note, students must adhere to all other uniform and appearance expectations and I have included a reminder below for your convenience.

## **Appearance**

As with uniform items, appearance issues will be addressed before the students are permitted to enter the main school. Please be aware that this may necessitate a request from staff to students to remove jewellery items or piercings. Ongoing breaches of our uniform policy will be dealt with using the school Behaviour Policy including the use of detentions and Isolation.

Jewellery	A single pair of small stud earnings are permitted.
	No further jewellery is allowed. **
Watches	A wristwatch can be worn but must be removed to take part in Physical Education
	lessons. No responsibility is accepted for the loss of any confiscated items.
Shoes	Black, sturdy and low heeled.
	Please note that fabric shoes, trainers or boots are not permitted.
Hair	Extremes of hair style and hair colouring are not acceptable and will be dealt with on
	a case by case basis.
	Long hair must be tied up for practical lessons.
Body	Nose studs and other forms of body piercing are not acceptable. **
Piercing	We ask for parental support in ensuring that students do not have any new piercings
	until they have completed Year 11.
