The LEA have continued to support the school on all fronts and have begun work on measures which will allow us to get more students on site. This work has started in the canteen area fitting a temporary kitchen. Further work will be undertaken over the forthcoming weeks and I will update parents & carers again, early next week with our future plans and timescales.

Teaching and Learning

Alongside the Year 10 and 11 students who continue to be on site, we look forward to welcoming the other year groups following the plan in the timetable below.

When students are on days where they are working remotely for next week they will continue to access the MS Stream videos recorded by staff and complete the work set on Class Charts. Students should continue to follow their normal timetable at home and they will have the equivalent of five hours' worth of work provided.

Looking ahead to Monday 27th, any remote lessons will take place on Microsoft Teams instead. This will allow us to record a formal register for students to raise questions and for staff to provide feedback. We will send further communication out next week with the timetable for students being on site from the 27th onwards and guidance on student expectations whilst working on Teams.

- All students will arrive to school and enter the school via the Student Entrance.
- Any form room changes will be displayed in the Student Entrance on arrival.
- During the students first form time of the week, form tutors will present information regarding the impact of RAAC at Bramhall High School; changes to the daily routine; catering provision and the support on offer.

Pre-Orders

- All students can pre-order cold food items such as sandwiches and baguettes to eat at lunchtime.
- Students can pre-order cold food items with designated catering staff who will be on duty in the **Refectory before school** and **during morning breaktime**.
